

Chris majored in theater at UTA, began performing professionally in 1975 and founded "The Gunfighters" in 1978 and Topher Productions in 1981. In 1999, he was joined by Phyllis Addison, his late wife, and together they merged these companies to create Lagniappe Productions and Lone Star Murder Mysteries.

Clients who have chosen Lagniappe Productions to produce their live entertainment include major amusement parks (Six Flags, SeaWorld, Gaylord Entertainment, Billy Bob's Texas, Grapevine Vintage Rail Road and others.) Lagniappe currently produces roughly 1,400 shows annually for multiple clients. Lagniappe is involved in film work, including work for the History Channel, independent films, MTV, direct to video, Outdoor Channel, and others. Lagniappe also owns the "Texas Star Dinner Theater" located in historic downtown Grapevine on Main St. The theater is the only true murder mystery dinner theater experience in North Texas and was selected "Best Entertainment in North Texas" for 2009 & 2010 by the readers of "Texas Meetings + Events" magazine.
