The general membership luncheon meeting of the RRWC was held on February 5, 2024.

Business Meeting:

Lisa Olson, President, called the meeting to order at 11:30 am, prior to the buffet lunch. In order to shorten the business portion of the meeting, Lisa introduced the new slide format. A slide show will continuously run during lunch. She asked that members pay particular attention to the treasury report. The following items were on the slide show:

- Treasurer's report: - There is a carry over from 2023 reserves of \$3,500. Operating funds from dues is \$6,200. Operating expenses YTD are \$736.41. This leaves remaining operating funds of \$5,463.59.
- Membership report - 307+ members
- Volunteers who served on the hospitality team as greeters, check-in volunteers and table decorators were acknowledged.
- Special Event - Trip to TWU Jane Nelson Institute will be on 2/13 at 1:00 pm.
- Social/Welcome - Spring Fling will be on 3/26 from 1:00-3:00 in the Clubhouse.
- Home & Garden Show - Will be on 3/16 from 9:00-2:00. Raffle tickets are being sold.
- Patio Tour - This is an activity for members and their guests with proceeds going to a charity.
- Community Outreach - Birthday box donations may be made to Lynn Teeling. There is a list of urgent items needed by Our Daily Bread.

Lisa Olson and Donna DeBoever introduced new members, first-time attendees and guests. We had 15 new members and one guest.

Shirley Monge celebrated the February birthdays. There was a drawing for the birthday card, free lunch and lottery ticket. The winner was Kathy Toothaker. Shirley reminded everyone that there were orange sheets on the tables and asked that members provide information on anyone needing a card on behalf of the Women's Club.

Lisa stated we have a total of 307 members with 19 members joining today, bringing our total to 326. She reminded everyone that separate checks are required for lunches and annual membership.

Suzanne Spisak gave an update on Community Outreach. The three charities we support are Our Daily Bread, Friends of the Family and Denton Community Food Center. A Community Outreach meeting will be held Monday, February 12th, at 10:00 am in the Clubhouse. Members that signed up on their membership forms for Community Outreach received an invitation, but all are welcome to attend. Information on tours of the charities will be forthcoming in the Women's Club newsletter. A list of items needed for the ODB Welcome Home Pallets is on each table. Members were encouraged to take a picture of this list.

Suzanne announced we raised \$1,800 today for this month's charity, Friends of the Family, birthday boxes. Our goal is to raise \$2,000. She thanked Lynn Teeling for all efforts on the birthday boxes. A drawing was held to Share the Blessings. Gina Ross won a free lunch.

Gayle Lee let everyone know the Spring Fling social party will be held March 26 from 1:00-3:00 in the Clubhouse with an informal style show by LeFashion Coach. March entertainment will be a Keltic theme with the McTeggart Irish Dancers of North Texas. Gayle introduced the speaker Debbie Deverich, who spoke about the 5 love languages, which is a book written by Gary Chapman. The 5 love languages are: (1) words of affirmation (2) quality time (3) giving/receiving gifts (4) acts of service and (5) physical touch.
