Michael and Andrew presented a humorous, practical, challenging and loving program with RRWC participation built around a simple but powerful motto: Love Loudly! Their program focus is on premise that every day we make “choices” and those choices influence and impact those around us. We should strive to respond to others with **yes** rather than no. Facial expression sets a mood even if the response is yes but your expression is saying no.

Three principles of Positively Outrageous recipe are fun and play; look beyond circumstance and invite random and unexpected. These are simple ingredients /choices to bring infectious love to those around you. They presented challenge of what does it really mean when you ask someone how they are and they reply “fine”. Fine can mean one is feeling like a freak out, insecure, neurotic or emotionally unstable but still will say I am fine. Suggest that you follow up or just ask how are you **really** doing? That person will know you are ready to really listen to their response/concerns. They left us with the challenge to call someone this afternoon you need to

impart love to and let that person know how much they meant to you in the past and that you really want to know how they are doing now.

Enjoyable interaction amongst RRWC members added to the interesting and enlightening presentation – just say Yes.
