Business Meeting:

Rose thanked all of the individuals on the Luncheon Committee and the Hospitality Committee (Check-in Volunteers, Greeters and Table Decorators) for doing such a great job today.

Lisa Olson reported for Community Outreach. She said that for the Back to School drive, the club has purchased back packs in bulk and is selling them for \$10 each. They are available today to purchase, but if you didn't get one, you can call Lisa to make arrangements to pick one up. She will leave it outside for members to pick up @ 9500 Crestview. Lisa has ordered more backpacks. Our goal for this year is to fill 190 backpacks to be distributed by Friends of the Family to abused children. We will be collecting back packs as we have done in the past with a drive through on 7/26.

Donna Gardner announced that we raised \$520 today as a donation to Friends of the Family. As part of Share the Blessings, ???? won a free lunch at our next luncheon meeting.

Rose reminded everyone of the pink sheets on the table and asked them to write down the names of people to receive a card from the Sunshine Committee.
