- Tour price of **\$115.00** per person includes bus transportation, tour, play ticket and wine on the return trip. **Bus and play seatmates must register and pay at the same time. Names listed but not registered and paid by July 1, 2019 are not guaranteed a spot.**
- You must be a current Robson Ranch Women's Club member to participate.
- Bus: If you desire additional snacks or beverages on the bus, please know that NO glass containers are allowed per the bus company. Robson Ranch tour guests are responsible for keeping the bus clean. Trash bags and hand cleaner wipes will be provided. All tour guests must ride the bus; **no exceptions.**
- There is no dress code for Bass Hall – wear what you like. The day trip will be conducted, rain or shine. Drinks and a limited selection of dry snacks are available for sale at bars located on various hall levels.
- Security: Guests will go through wanded security and cannot take any food or drink (**including leftovers**) into the theater. Purses should not be larger than 12x4x12. No photos during the performance.
- **To Register and Pay:** Complete the registration and waiver form, (available on the RRWC website), and make a separate check payable to RRWC for \$115.00 per person, noting "July 24 Day Trip". Register following the March 4 through July 1 RRWC meetings. The registration and waiver form, and your check, can also be dropped off at the home of Sally Hampton, 9013 Kingston Drive. There will be a drop box near the front door; please do not use the USPS mailbox. You must register, sign the waiver form, and pay no later than the RRWC lunch meeting on Monday, July 1, 2019.
