First Monday Trade Days in Canton, Texas is considered the largest flea market in the United States. Don't let the name fool you, Trade Days are held on Thursday through Sunday prior to the first Monday of the month. You might want to check out the website for more information at www.firstmondaycanton.com, as there are many vendors. We'll drop you off at the East Gate, near the "The Arbors", a very popular shopping area.

The details and approximate times for the day trip are:

- 8:30 am – Depart Robson Ranch - Bring you own coffee and board the bus at the RR Clubhouse – snacks provided
- 10:30 am – Arrive Canton
- 10:30 am – 2:30 pm – Shopping and lunch on your own
- 2:30 pm – Depart Canton – wine and snacks on the way home
- 4:30 pm – Arrive Robson Ranch
- To prepare for the trip, please read the information on the reverse side of this flyer.

The cost is **\$55.00** per person and we must have a minimum number of 40 to move forward with this activity before September 10. Once the minimum number is confirmed we'll deposit your check and continue to add attendees until mid-October. **Please sign up sooner than later so buses can be confirmed.**

- 2021 Robson Ranch Women's Club members only. Please wear your nametags.
- The trip will be conducted rain or shine.
- Wear comfortable walking shoes. Flip-flops and dress shoes are not recommended.
- Be prepared for changing temperatures by layering comfortable clothing.
- Wear sunscreen and re-apply frequently if sunny.
- You can bring a small shopping pull cart or wagon for your purchases. You'll place this in the luggage compartment under the bus, so please have your name on it.
- Please don't photograph vendor's merchandise without specific permission from the vendor.
- There are ATM's on the grounds. However, on busy months, they sometimes run out of money. **REMEMBER**, cash is king when bartering for that special item.
- We will use the East Gate as our meeting place.
- Don't rely on your cell phones. During very busy months, there is no signal on the grounds. Don't count on calling the FMC office if you need assistance. Offices are only allowed to page for lost children and in medical emergencies.
- There are plenty of food concession vendors and a food court. Many food vendors do not accept credit cards.
- Scooter rentals are available in several areas for those who can't walk long distances. BT&T will take cart reservations. They are located in Row 11, near Trade Center 1, and Row 37, near Highway 19. Phone 903 651 6573. Check the website for additional scooter rental options.

- **HOW TO REGISTER:** Make a separate check for \$55.00 payable to RRWC and indicate Canton Trip. Drop off your registration form and check at the August, September or October Women's Club luncheons, or at the home of:

 - Please place in the box on the walkway – not the mailbox.
 - ***Do not drop your check off at the Sport Club box*** – we do not have access.
- Due to contractual commitments, refunds ***will not*** be made for cancellations. Those who cancel may provide a substitute RRWC guest name. If no name is provided, cancelled spots will be filled from the waitlist.
- Last minute details will be sent to you via email a few days before the trip.
