The cost is **\$60.00** per person and there must be a minimum number of 40 to move forward with this activity. **Please sign up sooner than later.**

- This activity is limited to 50 people. A waitlist will be established.
- The trip will be conducted rain or shine. Wear comfortable walking shoes.
- Be prepared for changing temperatures by layering comfortable clothing.
- Some of the historic homes have stairs.
- McKinney maps will be provided when we arrive at the Visitor Center.
- The home tour is just a few blocks from the downtown McKinney shops and dining, a 5 to 10 minute walk.
