Current Realities

New guest numbers have doubled in 2019

More guests means more case management

In-kind food donations decline as food inventory systems improve

Need for expanded services - mail, showers, laundry, storage - is increasing as guest numbers grow

Greater on-site collaboration with 16 partners strains space resources

Security costs increase as guest numbers grow

Meal service to MKOC expanded by 82%
